CROSSMEMBER MOUNTS

- 1. Support vehicle under the sills (sills run down the side of the vehicle)
- 2. Conduct removal and installation one side at a time.
- 3. Remove the main bolt located through the crossmember bush and the 3 bolts connecting the cover plate to the crossmember. (See image below)
- 4. If you have a twin or big bore exhaust system you may be required to remove the hanger for clearance to the crossmember.
- 5. Lever that side of the crossmember down and pry the original bush from it mounting position. TIP: Use a tyre lever.
- 6. Clean the surface and check for any cracks or damage.
- 7. Fit the Noltec pad taking note of the thick and thin upper pads required using the information below.
- 8. Realign crossmember, mount cover plate and start the thread on the 3 cover plate bolts and the main crossmember bolt.
- 9. Torgue bolts to manufacturers' specifications
- 10. Perform these steps on the other side of the vehicle
